

WEST GEORGIA HOMESCHOOL ASSOCIATION FIELD TRIP GUIDELINES

As Christian homeschoolers we believe our field trip behavior should be above reproach.

In order to carry out this goal, WGHSA has adopted the following field trip guidelines.

1. A parent must accompany his/her children unless prior arrangements have been made with another parent to supervise the children.
2. Field trips are for WGHSA members only.
3. Each family is expected to arrive on time, pay any fees by the deadline, and dress appropriately for the trip.
4. Please observe the age limits set for each field trip and make necessary baby-sitting arrangements.
5. All children are expected to be well-behaved, respectful, and attentive during the entire field trip. Children are expected to be obedient to the adult in charge of the trip. Continued willful disobedience will be reported to the parent. If the child continues to behave inappropriately, he/she will not be allowed to attend field trips for the remainder of the school year.
6. Grandparents are allowed to go on WGHSA field trips if space is available. If there is a limited number of spaces, parents and their children are given first preference. If after the cutoff date there is still space available, it will be open to grandparents.
7. All field trips are on a first come first served basis. If a fee is required, parents and their children are not considered signed up until fee is paid.
8. When a payment is required in advance, please make all checks payable to WGHSA.
For most trips that require payment, the payment will be non-refundable after the deadline.
9. Please be mindful of the coordinator who is a volunteer. All information, including time and directions, will be distributed by the coordinator or the WGHSA email account.
